- 3. An official copy of the candidate's academic record and his/her latest SAT scores. <u>It must be signed by a school official and/or contain the school's official seal.</u>
- 4. At least <u>four</u> letters of recommendation. Two of the letters must be from school personnel and two from community representatives.
- 5. A resume which includes extra-curricular activities, community service and school service. (Please include an e-mail address).
- 6. An original (<u>not xeroxed</u>) black and white <u>or color passport size photograph</u>, which will be included in our journal if the applicant is a scholarship winner. It is recommended that the student write his/her name on the back of the photo and clip it to the application.
- 7. All applications should be mailed in a 9 x 12 inch envelope (with adequate postage), and postmarked no later than <u>April 30, 2018</u>. Please note that all materials become the property of Association of Black Educators of New York and will not be returned.
